Shield Installation

- 1.Take out the Shield on the Panel Frame protective packaging and the Screws in the bag.
- Tilt the Washing Machine backward and slowly put it down on a cushion.
- 3.Push the Shield straight along the Seat Slot until it is installed in place.
- 4.Fix the Shield and Seat with Screws.
- 5.Lift the Washing Machine gently until it is placed steadily.

Placement of the Washing Machine

- 1.Choose a dry place without direct sunlight to the Washing Machine.
- 2.Place the Washing Machine on steady solid ground.
- 3. The Washing Machine should be placed where there is a suitable drainage so as to drain water smoothly. The floor drainer shall be in the same plane as that where the Washing Machine is placed or slightly lower than the plane, to avoid Washing Machine leakage causing any damage.
- 4.Place the Washing Machine as firmly as possible. If necessary, level the Washing Machine by adjusting the Adjustable Feet of the Washing Machine according to the order shown in the figures. The maximum allowable inclination of the plane on which the Washing Machine is placed is 2°.

Notes:

- •When the Washing Machine is placed on the floor or a flexible support stand, the Washing Machine may vibrate. 2 Lower Raise
- •Do not place any object such as a carpet below the Washing Machine to prevent the bottom opening from being blocked.




At the end of the Spin cycle, Water is added into the drum. A rinse will start.

3.Spill Rinse (in the event too much detergent is being used)



At the end of the Spin cycle, Water is added into the drum while a rinse cycle starts. The foam produced during the rinse will overflow from the Spill Mouth and drained into the sewer.

2.Spray Rinse (water-saving)



After the spin-drying ends, the spin drier will rotate slowly while water is added. Like taking a shower, the laundry will have the detergent on it removed and drained to the sewer (the Washing Machine will immediately stop working when the Washer Lid is opened during the spray rinse).

Blanket Program Instructions


The Blanket Program applies to washing blankets and other large items.

•When this Program is used, the water level is automatically set to Level 8. However, you can change the Water Level to Level 5 ~ 8 according to the size of the blankets and large items.

Operation Steps

- 1. Open the Washer Lid and press the Power Button.
- 2.Press the 6th Sense Button until the Blanket Indicator is lit.
- 3. Pour the liquid detergent into the Washing Machine. If you are using powder detergent, dissolve it thoroughly in 5L of warm water (about 30°C) and then slowly pour the solution into the Washing Machine.
- 4. Place the rolled side of the blanket down in the Washing Machine.
- 5. Press the Start/Pause Button (If necessary, you can adjust the water level manually.)
- 6.Close the Washer Lid.
- •If the Washer Lid is not closed properly, the Washing Machine will automatically stop running before starting spin-drying.
- •After the wash ends, the beeper will emit beeps and then the power will be cut off automatically within 5 seconds.
- •After the wash ends, turn off the Faucet and clean the Lint Filter Pouch.

Take out the blanket and hang it from the middle in the shade. Notes: Pre-wash the dirty parts by hand.

- 2. Press the 6th Sense Button until the Wool Indicator is lit.
- 3.Pour the liquid detergent into the Washing Machine. If you are using powder detergent, dissolve it thoroughly in 5L of warm water (about 30°C) and then slowly pour the solution into the Washing Machine.
- 4. Put wool clothes in the Washing Machine.
- 5. Press the Start/Pause Button (If necessary, you can adjust the Water Level manually.)
- 6.Close the Washer Lid.
- •If the Drum Cover is not closed properly, the Washing Machine will automatically stop running before starting spin-drying.
- •After the wash ends, there will be beeps and the power will be cut off automatically within 5 seconds.
- •After the wash ends, turn off the Faucet and clean the Lint Filter Pouch.

Caution

- •The laundry amount shall be less than 1.5kg.
- •After the Program ends, please immediately take out the clothes and air them to prevent them from becoming deformed due to too long placement.
- •The Wool Program cannot be scheduled.
- •In order to avoid damage to the clothes, the temperature of the washing water shall not exceed 30°C.
- •Please wash clothes of white or bright colors and the clothes of dark colors separately. Using dedicated wool detergents can reduce the damage to clothes and improve the washing effect.

Description of other Functions, Method for Setting These Functions

Preset Time/ Schedule Function

- •The Pre-set schedule time is the program end time.
- •Before making a Preset , first turn on the Faucet, and then lay down the Drain Hose and check whether the Universal Joint is tightened to avoid water leakage accidents.

Operation Steps

- 1. Press the Preset Time Button.
- 2.If necessary, press the 6th Sense Button or the Procedure Button to select the appropriate laundry Program and Procedure Settings.
- 3.Press the Preset Time button to set the schedule end time. The Digital Display will show the set time, which is increased by one hour whenever the Button is pressed once. The maximum time is 24 hours.
- 4.If necessary, use the Water Level Button to set the appropriate Water Level. Add some detergent, softener, etc.
- 5.Press the Start/Pause Button
- 6.Close the Washer Lid.
- •All the Indicators except the " © "Indicator will go out in about one minute. (If the Child Lock is enabled, the Child Lock Indicator will be lit)
- Preset Wash is unavailable for the Gentle, Wool, Rinse+Spin, Spin and Tub Dry Programs.
- •If you want to check the Preset/ Scheduled Program, please press any Button other than the Power Button. Then the Preset/ Scheduled Program will be displayed for 5 seconds.
- •To change the Preset/ Scheduled Program, please turn off the power and then restart the Machine and carry out the resetting.

Instructions for Adding Detergent for a Preset Wash

- •Synthetic powder detergent can be directly added into the Drum.
- •Liquid detergent and bleach can be poured directly into the hole in the Panel Frame but not directly on the laundry. Otherwise, they may cause fading of clothes.
- •After softener is diluted with water of a volume 2 times that of the softener to be used, pour the diluted softener into the Softener Inlet. Please do not use soap, because it cannot be dissolved easily and will lead to a poor washing effect.

Smart Memory Function

If you choose the Preset, Normal or Heavy Duty Program the Washing Machine will remember your choice after the Program ends. When you use the Machine the next time, the remembered Program will be displayed after you turn on the power. The Machine will start running when you simply press the Start/Pause Button.

•For the Normal or Heavy Duty Program, no wash parameters but only the Program will be remembered.

Two-step Clean Function

During the washing process, after the water level of the washing machine reaches the level that is two levels lower than the pre-set water level, the wash will start while water is added.

- •When the two lowest levels are set, the wash will start after the pre-set water levels are reached.
- •The Two-step Clean Function is unavailable for the Gentle, Wool and Blanket Programs
- If the Soak Time Procedure is selected, after the soak ends, the Two-step Clean Function will be disabled during the wash.

Description of other Functions, Method for Setting These Functions

Pre-wash Function

As the drum is being filled with water, push the Pre-Wash Switch. Water will flow out from the Pre-Wash mouth. Then you can manually wash the laundry partially.

When the added water reaches the set Water Level, water addition will automatically stop.

Water Level (Varied Wash) Function

In order to improve the detergent content in the washing water and save water, you can set different water levels for a wash and rinse respectively. It is recommended that the wash proceeds at a lower water level and the rinse at a higher water level. In this way, a clean wash and a thorough rinse can be ensured.

Setting Method

Press the Power Button to turn on the power. After selecting the appropriate Program, press the Washing Time Button to set the washing time, press the Water Level button to set the wash water level, press the Rinsing Times Button to set the rinsing times, press the Water Level Button again to set the rinsing water level, press the Spin Button to set the spin-drying time, and finally, press the Start/Pause Button to start. Then the wash and rinse will proceed at different pre-set water levels.

Residual Water Draining Function

After it is enabled, within 9 minutes after the Program ends, the Drain Valve will open automatically to drain the remaining water inside the Machine to prevent it from becoming frozen when the weather turns cold. (Used when the temperature is below 0°C)

Setting Method

•Press the Power Button. Press and hold the Spin Button for more than 3 seconds until you hear a beep. Repeat the operation to enable beeps.

Tub Light Function

The Tub Light will be lit when the Washer Lid is opened and will go out 2 minutes after the Washer Lid is closed. The Tub Light will go out automatically 3 minutes after the Washer Lid is not closed.

Soak Function

After the Soak Function is enabled, a dynamic soak can be added before a wash (this function is unavailable for the Gentle, Wool, Blanket, Rinse+ Spin, Spin and Tub Dry Programs). The soaking time is 0 - 40 minutes with an increment of 5 minutes.

Description of other Functions, Method for Setting These Functions

Child Lock Function

You can enable the Child Lock Function to avoid injury to a child opening the Washer Lid of the Washing Machine.

Setting Method

Press the Power Button to turn on the power. Press and hold the Function Button for more than 3 seconds until you hear a beep. Repeat the operation to enable it again.

- •After the Child Lock is enabled, the Washing Machine will stop running and display " **£5**" and emit alarming beeps when the Washer Lid is opened for more than 5 seconds during a wash.
- •After the Child Lock is enabled, while a Program is running, no Buttons except the Power Button will respond.

Disabling Beeps

Cancel Method: Press the Power Button. Press and hold the Start/Pause Button for more than 3 seconds until you hear a beep. Repeat the operation to enable beeps.

Non-malfunction Cases

- 1. Sometimes water is added during a wash or rinse. This is automatic water replenishment due to a lowered water level.
- 2.At the beginning of Spin-drying, the Drum will stop and start intermittently. This is intermittent Spin-drying designed to achieve a better Spin-drying effect.
- 3. During the Spill Rinse, the Drain Hose does not drain water. This is due to the set water level being too low or the water pressure being too low.
- 4. Sometimes water is replenished during Spin-drying. This is an automatic replenishment due to the improper placement of the laundry to be Spin-dried.
- 5. After the Spin-drying ends, there is the sound of residual water, which is the sound of the balance liquid that is in the balance ring and designed to reduce Spin-drying vibration.
- 6. There was a power failure during operation and the operation cannot be automatically resumed after the power supply restores. Please set the Machine again.

TROUBLE SHOOTING GUIDE

When the following problems occur, the microcomputer will detect the abnormal condition and an electronic buzzer sounds for approximately 10 seconds and the indicators flash as shown below. At the same time, the washer stops operation.
