# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

## Installing the Bottom Cover

- 1. Unplug the Power Cord from the washer.
- 2.Gently lay down the backside of washer on a soft mat or cushion.(Be careful not to dent the Frame.)
- 3. Insert the attached Bottom Cover into the hooks of Leg by pushing until it reaches into the front hooks.
- 4. Fasten the Bottom Cover with a screw.
- 5.Gently set the washer upright.





## Attaching the "Magic" Hose Joint to a Faucet

Faucet: Type A is the most suitable



Type B: The length of the mouth of the faucet needs to be at least 16mm. If it is less than 16mm, the "Magic" Hose Joint can not be installed. Type C: It may cause water leakage.

#### **CAUTIONS:**

## How to Attach the "Magic" Hose Joint


- 1.Loosen the four screws and slide the top of the "Magic"Hose Joint(section A in the figure)onto the faucet. Then, securely tighten the four screws provided with the "Magic" Hose Joint by using a screwdriver to secure the top of the joint to the faucet.
- 2. Remove the CAUTION label from the "Magic" Hose Joint.
- 3. Turn the male coupler on the joint (section B in the figure) clockwise to attach it securely to the top of the joint (section A in the figure).
- The appliance is to be connected to the water mains using new Water Supply Hose and "Magic" Hose Joint.



 The new hose-sets supplied with the appliance are to be used and the old hose-sets should not be reused.


#### **CAUTION:**


### Installing Water Supply Hose to the Washer

- 1. Turn the nut clockwise while holding the hose.
- Turn the nut counterclockwise after turning the faucet off when you want to detach the Water Supply Hose.



## Connecting the Water Supply Hose to the "Magic" Hose Joint


- 1.While pushing the sleeve on the female coupler (section D in the figure) of the joint down with your fingers, connect the female coupler to the male coupler (section C in the figure).
- Release the sleeve, then push the Water Supply Hose up into the "Magic" Hose Joint until it clicks into place.
- 3.Pull the Water Supply Hose down to make sure that it is securely attached.



## How to Detach the Water Supply Hose

Please read the following procedure in order to avoid water leakage when detaching the Water Supply Hose.

- 1.Turn the faucet off.
- 2.Press the POWER ON/OFF button to turn the power on ,the MIXED button and the START/PAUSE button.
- Press the POWER ON/OFF button to turn the power off 15 seconds later.
- 4. While pushing the lock lever and the sleeve on the female (section D in the figure) of the joint down with your fingers, detach the female coupler from the male coupler (section C in the figure).

## Installing The Drain Hose

Set the clip part of Hose Band sideways to prevent touching the frame which may cause a vibration noise.



## Changing the Drain Hose Direction

You can change the direction from right side to left side.

#### NOTE:

- 1. Unplug the Power Cord of the washer.
- 2.Detach the Back Cover by loosening screws at the back side of the washer. Detach outer Drain Hose and gently lay down the front side of washer on a soft mat or cushion.



- 5. Push the joint on the drain hole and pull the drain hose out of the drain hole on the right side of the washer.
- 6.Let the inner Drain Hose through outside of left hole and set the protrusive guard of inner Drain Hose to the square cutting part of frame, then attach the Drain Outtet of the hose until it snap into place.
- 7.Connect the inner Drain Hose to the Drain Valve in place and fix the Hose Clip as shown above.
- if you do not attach correct position marked with ▲,it can damage the inner Drain Hose and cause water to leak through.
- 8. Attach the Cap to the right hole.
- 9. Reattach Back Cover and gently set the washer upright.



- 5. Close the washer lid
- The washer buzzer will sound and stop running before spinning if the washer lid is not closed.
- You can use softener, by pouring the softener slowly into Softener Dispenser before washing.

#### TWO RINSE TYPES:

  - The machine will remember the last customized selections made.

NOTE: The programme used for the evaluation of WVFC900AJGR under the mandatory Water Efficiency Labelling Scheme (WELS) and the recommended Washing Programme for soiled clothes is as follows: Mixed program with water level 8.

# **OPERATION**

#### TIME DELAY

- 1. Turn on the faucet on and load the laundry into the washer, make sure to fit the Drain Hose.
- 2. Press POWER ON/OFF button.
- 3. Select PROGRAM, FUNCTION and WATER LEVEL.
- 4. Press FUNCTION button till light of TIME DELAY flashes, press SET to select your needed TIME DELAY time (the time washing finished).
  - TIME DELAY indication:  $6 \rightarrow 7 \rightarrow 8 \rightarrow \cdots 24 \rightarrow 0 \rightarrow 1 \cdots 5$  hours
- 5. Press START/PAUSE button.
- 6. Put the detergent into the washer and close washer lid.
  - All the lights except TIME DELAY will be lighted off in about one minute later. if the child lock has been set, the child lock light will light up.
  - Directly put the detergent into the detergent box.
  - TIME DELAY confirming: Press SET button to indicate FUNCTION about 5 seconds.
  - TIME DELAY cancel, change: TIME DELAY is canceled automatically when power off: Switch power on and set TIME DELAY again to change it.
  - This function is not available for DELICATE program.

#### **BEDDING**

- 1. Press POWER ON/OFF on and put the drainage hose.
- 2. Turn on the faucet and press PROGRAM button till BEDDING light flashes.
- 3. Prepare separately for the warm water around 5L (approx.30°C) to dissolve the detergent. And pour it into the washing tub.
- 4. Fold up the bedding as the method showed in the figures below and place it into the washer tub.

- 5. Press START/PAUSE button.
- Close the washer lid.

# **OPERATION**

#### DELICATE

- Before washing wool, fiber and other delicate fabrics, please refer to the care label.
- When this program is set, the water level will be set at 6 automatically. But you could change the water level to 3~8 according to the amount of laundry.

## Order of operations

- 1. Open the washer lid and press POWER button.
- 2. Press "PROGRAM" button till the light of DELICATE turn on.
- 3. Add the liquid detergent, dissolve it into a 5L warm water (about 30°C) if powder detergent is used, then pour it into the laundry slowly.
- 4. Put the delicate clothing into the washing machine.
- 5. Press the START/PAUSE button. (adjust the water level accordingly)
- 6. Close the washer lid.
- If the washer lid is not closed, washing machine will stop automatically
- The buzzer will alarm at the end of operation and the power will be switched off automatically after 5 seconds.
- Then turn off water tap and clean the filter.

#### NOTE:

- •The washing capacity should be under 1.5 kg when selecting delecate program.
- Remove laundry and hang out after the program. Otherwise it will be out of shape after a long period of time the washer.
- Time Delay is not available in this program.
- •The temperature should be under 30°C in order not to damage the clothes.
- •Please separate the light color clothes with the dark one.
- •The washing performance will be better if special purpose detergent is used. And do less damage to the clothes.

#### WATER LEVEL SETTING

This button allows you to choose the appropriate water level during WASH/RINSE process. Method:

Press FUNCTION till WASH light flashes, press WATER LEVEL button to choose the appropriate water level, press SET button to set wash time. Then press FUNCTION button till RINSE light flashes, press WATER LEVEL button to choose the appropriate water level, press SET button to set RINSE times and RINSE type. Then press FUNCTION button till SPIN light flashes, press SET button to set SPIN time. Finally press START/PAUSE, the washer will start operating according to the wash water level and rinse water level as set.

#### **CHILD LOCK FUNCTION**

This function avoids any accidental operation of the washer.

Method of setting:

Press POWER ON/OFF button to switch on the power, and press PROGRAM button for 4 seconds till a sound from buzzer. To restore it, repeat above.

When CHILD LOCK is set, the CHILD LOCK on control panel lights, and indicates E5 and buzzes if washer lid open for 5 seconds during washing.

#### **MUTE THE END BUZZER**

Press POWER ON/OFF button to switch on the power, and press START/PAUSE button for 4 seconds till a sound from buzzer. To restore it, repeat above.

## **OPERATION**

#### **MEMORY FUNCTION**

When select MIXED or STAIN WASH, 30 seconds after starting, the washer will remember this program and starts the same customised setting.

- •This function is not available for DELICATE/BEDDING/EXPRESS WASH/TUB CLEAN program.
- WATER LEVEL and TIME DELAY will not be remembered.
- The WASH, RINSE, SOAK and SPIN for MIXED program could be remembered.
- To reset memory function, pull out plug.

#### **HOW TO DRAIN REMAINING WATER**

When select this function, in 9 minutes after the working finished, the drainage valve will open to drain out the remained water inside. This will avoid water freezing inside in winter when temperature below  $0^{\circ}$ C.

Method of Use

Press POWER ON/OFF button to switch on the power, and press FUNCTION button for 4 seconds till a sound from buzzer. To restore it, repeat above or pull out the plug.

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. Q: During Washing or Rinsing stage, there is still water flowing in.
  - A: This is possible as water might be added into the washer automatically due to decrease of water level
- 2. Q: The washer tub turns or stops timely at the beginning of Spinning stage.
  - A: This is known as intermittent spinning, which is for a better spinning effect.
- 3. Q: There is inflow of water during Rinsing or Spinning stage sometimes.
  - A: This is to re-balance the laundry load as they might be distribute equally inside the washer tub.
- 4. Q: There is "water-flowing" sound after Spinning stage.
  - A: This is the sound of balance liquid in Balance Ring, to reduce the spinning vibration.
- 5. Q: Control panel feels warm after power is switched off.
- A: Memory function is activated after power is switched off.
- 6. Q: Power is suddenly switched off and the washer could not continue washing.
  - A: Turn on the washer and set the washing program again.

## TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

When the following problem occur, the sensor puter will detect the abnormal condition and an electronic buzzer sounds for approximately 10 seconds and the indicators flash as shown below:
